THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH

BY-LAW NUMBER 94- 55

A BY-LAW TO AMEND CHAPTER 684 OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH MUNICIPAL CODE - LITTERING

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH by the Council thereof hereby enacts as follows:

That Chapter 684 of the Corporation of the City of Peterborough Municipal Code is hereby repealed and following substituted thereof:

"CHAPTER 684 LITTERING - PROHIBITED

Article 1 INTERPRETATION

- 684.1.1 City defined
- "City" means The Corporation of the City of Peterborough.

684.1.2 Garbage container - defined
"garbage container" has the same meaning as contained in Chapter 594, City of Peterborough Municipal Code.

- 684.1.3 Litter defined "litter" includes all waste, garbage, rubbish, debris, material, refuse, discarded paper or wrappers, and any other discarded or abandoned commodities.
- Receptacle defined

"receptacle" means any barrel, bin, dumpster, or other device placed on property, by the owner or occupant of such property, for the disposal of litter.

Article 2 GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 684.2.1 Litter deposit in receptacle only
 No person shall throw, deposit, drop or place litter on any
 property except in a receptacle or a garbage container.
- Deposit not in receptacle consent of owner 684.2.2 Notwithstanding Section 684.2.1, litter may be deposited on property, not in a receptacle or garbage container, with the consent of the owner or occupant of such property, provided such deposit complies with all applicable law in regard to the deposit of waste, and the property is designated and approved pursuant to applicable law for the receipt of such waste.
- Deposit in private receptacle consent required 684.2.3 No person shall place litter in a receptacle or a garbage container which is not owned by the City except with the consent of the owner of such receptacle or garbage container.
- Deposit in public receptacle generated elsewhere No person shall deposit any litter, generated at a residence, institution or place of business, in a receptacle owned by the City.
- Control of litter prevention blowing other transfer 684.2.5 No person shall permit litter to be blown or otherwise transferred or conveyed from the property occupied by him or her on to any

lane, street, creek, water course, roadway or other property in the City.

- 684.2.6 Transportation waste covered vehicle trailer
 No person shall transport waste in the City in a motor vehicle or
 trailer, unless such waste is completely covered in such a manner
 as to prevent any of the waste from leaving the motor vehicle or
 trailer while it is in transit.
- **684.2.7** Waste disposal transportation provincial power Nothing in this Chapter shall be so interpreted or applied to derogate from the powers of the provincial government in regard to the disposal or placement of waste or in regard to the handling or transportation of waste.
- 684.2.8 Waste disposal transportation federal power
 Nothing in this Chapter shall be so interpreted or applied to
 derogate from the powers of the federal government in regard to the
 disposal or placement of waste or in regard to the handling or
 transportation of waste under federal jurisdiction.

Article 3 SEVERABILITY

684.3.1 Severability

If any section of this Chapter may be found by any court of law to be illegal or beyond the power of Council to enact, such section shall be deemed to be severable and all other sections of this Chapter shall be deemed to be separate and independent therefrom.

Article 4 ENFORCEMENT

684.4.1 Fine - for contravention

Any person who contravenes this Chapter is guilty of an offence and shall be liable upon conviction to a fine imposed by law, and the same shall be recoverable pursuant to the <u>Provincial Offences Act.</u>"
