

A BY-LAW RESPECTING MOTORIZED SNOW VEHICLES

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PETERBOROUGH BY THE COUNCIL THEREOF ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this by-law:

- (a) "highway" includes a common and public highway, street, avenue, parkway, driveway, square, place, bridge, viaduct or trestle, designed and intended for or used by, the general public for the passage of vehicles
- (b) "motorized snow vehicle" means a self-propelled vehicle designed to be driven primarily on snow
- (c) "holiday" means Sunday, Christmas Day, Boxing Day and New Years' Day
- (d) "Corporation" means the Corporation of the City of Peterborough
- (e) "limits of the Corporation" means the territorial limits of the Corporation of the City of Peterborough

2. No person shall have, keep, operate or drive a motorized snow vehicle in and upon any land owned, occupied or under the management and control of the Corporation other than in and upon a public highway or in any area designated for the parking of such motorized snow vehicle.

3. No person shall operate or drive a motorized snow vehicle within the limits of the Corporation unless such motorized snow vehicle is equipped with a red pennant, such pennant being attached to the top of an aerial at least 60 inches above the lowest point of the vehicle and having minimum dimensions of 6 inches by 9 inches.

4. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 2 herein, no person shall operate or drive a motorized snow vehicle within the limits of the Corporation between the hours of 11:00 o'clock in the afternoon and 7:00 o'clock in the forenoon of the next following day.

5. The provisions of Section 4 do not apply between the hours of 11:00 o'clock and 12:00 o'clock in the afternoon of the day immediately preceeding any Saturday or holiday and between the hours of 12:01 o'clock and 1:00 o'clock in the forenoon of any such Saturday or holiday.

6. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 2, 3, 4 and 5 herein, a servant, agent or employee of the Corporation may operate or drive a motorized snow vehicle at any time and at any place within the limits of the Corporation if such vehicle is actually engaged in work undertaken by or on behalf of the Corporation.

7. The owner of a motorized snow vehicle shall incur the penalties provided for any contravention of this by-law unless at the time of contravention the motorized snow vehicle was in the possession of some person other than the owner without the owner's consent, and the driver or operator of the motorized snow vehicle not being the owner shall also incur the penalties provided herein.

8. Every person who knowingly or unknowingly trespasses on public land while operating a motorized snow vehicle is guilty of an offence and on summary conviction is liable to a fine not exceeding \$500.00.

9. Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on summary conviction where a fine for the contravention is not otherwise provided for herein, is liable to a fine not exceeding \$300.00.

10. By-law Number 1971-153 is hereby repealed.
